2.	Completed A-Level studies before 2014 and 2015	Two principal passes (Two Cs) with a total of 4.0 points from Two Subjects defining the admission into the respective programme (where A=5; B+ =4; B=3; C=2; D=1;).
3.	Completed A-Level studies before 2014 and 2016 onwards	Two principal passes with a total of 4.0 points from Two Subjects defining the admission into the respective programme (where A=5; B=4; C=3; D=2; E=1).
4.	Recognition of Prior Learning qualification	B+ Grade: where A=75-100, B+=65-74, B=50-64, C=40-49, D35-39, F=0-38.
5.	Equivalent qualification	At least four O' Level passes (D's and above) or NVA Level III with less than four O'-Level passes of equivalent foreign qualifications as established by either

		NECTA or VETA; AND
		i)At least a GPA of 3.0 for Ordinary Diploma (NTA Level 6); OR
		ii)Average of C for full Technician Certificate (FTC) (where A=5,B=4,C=3, and D=2 points); OR
		iii)Average of 'B' Grade for Diploma in Teacher Education; OR
		iv)Average of 'B' Grade for Health-related awards such as Clinical Medicine and others; OR
		v)A distinction for unclassified diplomas and certificates.
		vi)Upper Second Class for classified non-NTA diplomas.
