CALL FOR PAPERS (TJSS VOL. 2 (1), JUNE 2024)

TUMA Journal of Social Sciences (TJSS) is a biannual peer-reviewed research journal published by Tumaini University Makumira. Its mission is to serve researchers in social sciences, and affiliated professionals around the world by publishing and disseminating significant research articles, novel ideas, and reviews in any subfield of social sciences. Its vision is to become a leading East African research journal, with notable and insightful contributions to the social sciences field.

General Guidelines for Contributors:

- a) TJSS publishes original, novel, and thought-provoking peer-reviewed research and non-research articles in any subfield of social sciences. All manuscripts should be emailed to the Editor-in-Chief via tjss@makumira.ac.tz.
- b) The first page should include the title of the paper, name of the author (s), institution and email address.
- c) Manuscripts should be in MS Word format (preferably MS Word 2007 and above) and should be submitted as email attachments. Manuscripts should be in Times New Roman, with a spacing of 1.5.
- d) The length of an article should not exceed 8000 words (including diagrams and/or other visual illustrations). Abstracts should not be more than 200 words. Articles and reviewed papers published in TJSS are those that are not published or intended for publication in another journal.

- e) All manuscripts should be written in either English or Kiswahili and should be in the APA formatting style. References should follow APA 7th edition.
- f) TJSS retains the right to edit the content and style of submitted and accepted manuscripts.
- g) Final proofs of research articles and reviews will be emailed to authors for correction. Authors should respond to the Editor-in-Chief in at most five days after receiving the proofs.
- h) The deadline for receiving manuscripts is 30th March 2024.
