IMPORTANT NOTE:

- A special examination fee of Tsh. 50,000.00 shall be assessed for each special examination paper provided to the student. The fee must be paid in advance and pay-in-slip be presented to Finance Department to be issued TUMA payment receipt.
- A supplementary examination fee of Tsh. 10, 000.00 per paper shall be assessed for each supplementary examination provided to the student. The fee must be paid in advance and pay-in-slip be presented to Finance Department.
- A repeat course examination fee of Tsh. 900,000 shall be assessed for each repeated course exam paper provided to the student. The fee must be paid in advance and pay-in-slip be presented to Finance Department. University ID and letter of permission given by the DVCAA's Office for special and repeat cases before entering into the exam room.
- Each Candidate will have to show to the invigilator at the door during inspection, payment receipts, examination card, University ID and letter of permission given by the DVCAA's Office for special and repeat cases before entering into the exam room.
- Invigilators have to put a tick ✓, sign, and note the date and session on each payment receipt for an examination paper from Tuma Finance Department (A student should interview papers on the receipt. Write the Course Code and Name).
- Adhere to TUMA DRESSING code. Acquaint yourself with TUMA General examination Regulations. Be on a queue, avoid any irregularity.
