NB: IMPORTANT NOTE:

1. A special examination fee of Tsh. 50,000.00 shall be assessed for each special examination paper provided to the student. The fee must be paid in advance to the University Account and pay-in-slip be presented to Finance Department.
2. A supplementary examination fee of Tsh. 10, 000.00 per paper shall be assessed for each supplementary examination provided to the student. The fee must be paid in advance to the University Account and pay-in-slip be presented to Finance Department.
3. A repeat course examination case, A fee of Tshs. 215,000 shall be assessed for each repeated course exam paper provided to the student. The fee must be paid in advance to the university Account and pay in slip be presented to finance Department.
4. Each Candidate will have to show, payment receipts, examination card University ID and letter of permission given by the Examinations Office for the case of special and repeat cases before entering into the Examination room.
5. Invigilators have to put a tick ✓, sign, and write the date and session on each payment receipt for an examination paper from Tuma Finance Department (A student should list exam papers on the receipt. Write the Course Code and Name) for the case of special and repeat Cases before entering Into the Examination room.
